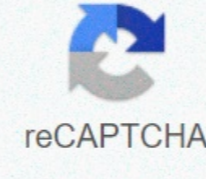

Each lesson contains 6 to 8 words. Each lesson ends with a small exercise where you either fill in the blanks, liken words to their meaning, or recognize a word, and then write down its definition. Each lesson begins with three words, which are ordered in different difficulties from the simplest to the hardest. You will find that each word follows its part of speech, pronunciation, definition, example sentences, etymology, and finally, an interesting tidbit. Thematic structure In addition to making things interesting, many lessons have been created according to a particular topic, i.e. lesson 17 theme is Just Fools Rush In This topic contains words that mean cautious and thoughtful. An example of a word layout is as follows: Words from French French gave us a surprising amount of English words, everything from restaurant to denim. Please pay close attention to the pronunciation of these words, as they may differ significantly from what you expect. Nonchalant (adj.) nánSH? lán Giving away a feeling of peace and cold. Katy reassured opponents by nonchalantly walking to court, only when the whistle exploded with fury. Nonchalant is derived from the French word means indifferent or not caring. Nonchalant is synonymous with insouciant (see sidebar) and is much more commonly used. It's not just another list of words I personally really like, as this book is not another list of vocabulary. Instead, the book layout gives you additional cues to help you preserve the meaning of the word. I've noticed that when I try to memorize a list of words one by one, I tend to forget most, if not all of them, a few minutes after the book's conclusion. In this regard, the thematic assortment of words and tidbits, etc., really help commit the newly learned word into memory. However, please don't go into this book thinking you will magically learn hundreds of new words by just reading them as you would a novel. In my opinion, the best way to make sure that you remember words and their meanings is to randomly go back and revise them. It is also good to do exercises on a separate piece of paper so you can remake them several times, which is the best way to enhance the meanings. Moreover, I cannot stress enough how important reading is in everyday life. Reading newspapers and professional magazines in addition to this book will give you the best chance to learn and remember words. The abundance of well-curated words of 1,400 words included in the book are selected carefully. Words cover a whole range of dark gre words. Are you sure to find almost all of these on GRE. However, learning 1400 words is not an easy task. You can learn all of them only if you have 3-4 months dedicated to GRE prep. If not, then I would suggest that you turn to other word lists and ignore this book altogether. Easy to understand definition definitions are not very technical and can be easy to understand for beginners. Many gre words have multiple meanings, and GRE tends to focus on their secondary meanings. Magoosh ensures that it teaches you only those meanings that are important from the point of view of GRE. In addition, Magoosh has done a commendable job in organising and grouping words to much easier. Other cues of Magoosh are not just shared words, their meanings and examples of sentences in this book. They also have roots, tidbits, themes, pronunciation, and etymology. All of these, especially roots, make memorizing, and retention easier. An excellent example of a sentence learning only definitions will not do much if you do not know how to use them in a sentence. Especially on GRE, use is more important than just knowing the literal meaning of a word. And in this sense, Magoosh contains easy to understand sentences that give you a clear idea of the use of words. Words ordered by difficulty It is always good to know where you stand when you are learning something new. Knowing the difficulty levels of words lets you know what kind of words you need to spend more time. Magoosh arranged these words in their order of difficulty, starting with the simplest and going to the hardest. Educational activities At the end of each chapter, Magoosh shares a wide range of activities where you can try it yourself. I recommend you try activities. This will allow you to reinforce what you have learned. You should not only revise the words, but also remake the activities once every few days. Just know the definition and think that you know it's not the same as actually testing yourself. A few exercise exercises included at the end of each lesson are too short and few. It would be nice if Magoosh included more practice exercises because these are the most useful tools for remembering new words. Few inaccuracies There are only a few inaccuracies and typos here and there. For example, the word centripetal is defined as moving away from the center of a point; However, the correct definition is towards the middle. However, the book has been thoroughly scanned to correct any errors. The bottom line and line dictionary builder workbook Magoosh is an excellent overall resource to add to your arsenal. There are many useful words if you are preparing for a standardized test such as GRE. Definitions are easy to understand, and other information regarding words is also useful. However, this book is not for everyone, because learning 1400 words is impossible for any GRE candidate. If you are someone who is trying 162+ on the verbal section of GRE, then you should consider using this book. Books.
